






DISCLAIMER

IFC-IOR Comment. The recent attacks in the Red Sea marks recommencement of targeting of commercial shipping since Nov 24, with vessels linked to Israel remaining the primary focus. Analysis of these incidents reveals that the non-state actors are not only targeting ships with direct Israeli connections, but also vessels under the same ownership or management that have previously called at Israeli ports. All vessels and shipping companies are strongly advised to conduct a comprehensive risk assessment to identify any potential associations that could pose a risk during transit through the Red Sea/ Bab el-Mandeb Strait. IFC-IOR recommends all vessel masters to strictly adhere to enhanced security protocols and maintain heightened vigilance when transiting through this region.
