#### Container Ship PUMBA Targeted in Mulitiple Attacks

On 20 Jul 24, the Liberia flagged container ship *PUMBA*, crewed by 26 members and three armed security personnel, was subjected to multiple attacks by Uncrewed Aerial Systems (UAS), Uncrewed Surface Vessels (USV), and missiles, 64 nautical miles northwest of Al Mukha, Yemen.

The master reported an initial UAS attack that exploded 5 to 10 meters from the vessel, causing a fire in the steering compartment, which the crew quickly controlled. In a second attack, the vessel was approached by three skiffs, two manned and one seemingly unmanned (USV/WBIED). The vessel's Armed Security Team opened fire on the unmanned skiff, which subsequently exploded about 30 meters from its port side quarter, causing no damage. Additionally, a missile exploded about 5 meters on the starboard side, causing no damage to the vessel. Two UAS were sighted but later reported out of sight by the master.

A third attack involved a second missile that exploded before reaching the vessel. Due to poor visibility, the exact distance could not be determined, but the explosion reportedly occurred 30-50 meters away. The Company Security Officer also reported a missile impact in the water about 100 meters on the starboard side of the vessel. A hole was later discovered in the stern, likely from one of the multiple attacks, though the specific incident remains uncertain. This hole, located 6 meters above the waterline, poses no stability issues or pollution concerns.

#### **Tankers Ablazed After Collision**

On 19 Jul 24, a fire incident occurred following a collision between the Singapore flagged tanker HAFNIA NILE and the Sao Tome and Principe-flagged tanker CERES I, approximately 34 nautical miles northeast of Pedra Branca, Malaysia. The HAFNIA NILE with 22 crew members, carrying 300 thousand barrels of naphtha, collided with the CERES I, which had 40 crew members and was loaded with 2 million barrels of Iranian crude oil. Singapore authorities rescued all 22 crew members from the HAFNIA NILE and evacuated 14 from the CERES I. The remaining 26 crew members of the CERES I stayed onboard to extinguish the fire.

### Major Fire On Container Ship MAERSK FRANKFURT Off Indian Coast

On 19 Jul 24, a major fire broke out on the Panama flagged container ship MV MAERSK FRANKFURT, off Betul in Goa, India. One crew member, a Philippines national succumbed to burn injuries while fighting the fire. The vessel, carrying 21 crew members of various nationalities and International Maritime Dangerous Goods (IMDG) cargo, was en route from Mundra Port, India to Colombo, Sri Lanka. The fire, believed to have started due to a short circuit, caused explosions and spread rapidly.

The Indian Coast Guard and Navy responded promptly, dispatching ships and aircraft equipped with firefighting tools. Despite ongoing efforts, the fire continues to rage, with containers still exploding on deck. Efforts to control the situation are ongoing, including potential plans for towing the vessel.
